The next quarterly meeting is scheduled for 9/30/2018 to be held immediately following the worship service. The following is a list of agenda items for the meeting;

- 1) Introduce and discuss the role of “Church Life Elder Liaison”. The position was introduced at the annual meeting. The position is being developed to help facilitate and improve communication between the various groups and offices within the church.
- 2) The main portion of our building is in need of a new roof. A few roofing contractors have been contacted for estimates. The roof surface is approximately 40 square (4,000 square feet). We have had quotes from \$19,500 to \$24,000. It is crucial that we make a decision and move ahead with the repairs soon before the roof begins to leak. We will be asking the membership to make some decisions regarding the contractor we should use, and funding the project.
- 3) Church Janitor position

All members and adherents are invited and encouraged to attend the quarterly meeting. We would like all who consider Cato Christian Fellowship their church home to be informed in terms of the operation of our church. The only restriction in terms of our business meetings is that voting is restricted to those who have committed to church membership
