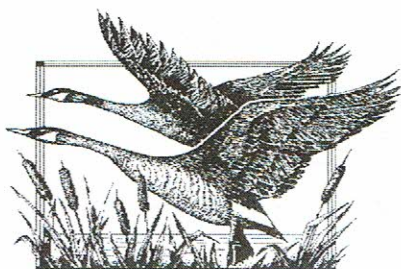

Jesus has supremacy, but we are still battling

- The message of Hebrews
- Heb. 10:39 – “But we are not of those who shrink back”

Jesus is the victor, Satan is a defeated foe!
