To Obey is Better Than Sacrifice
Please turn to Hebrews 10 (pg. 1,006 in the pew Bible)

Hebrews is filled with exhortations to *hold fast* to the faith!

- Hebrews 2:1 - We must pay much closer attention to what we have heard, lest we drift away from it.

Hebrews 10:1 - Since the law has but a shadow...

- Shadow
- Desired outcome / The Gospel

Hebrews 10:2... would they not have ceased...

- Couldn't happen through the law

Hebrews 10:3... reminder of sin every year

- Sacrifices not point to themselves as the solution
- Could not take away sin

Hebrews 10:4 ... it is impossible...

- Impossible for anything to take away sins...

Hebrews 10:5 - Consequently when Christ came...

- To Obey is better than sacrifice
- Psalm 51:16
- 1 Samuel 15

Christ's sacrifice represents that which is most precious to God... honoring Him, trusting Him, Loving Him enough to do His will.
