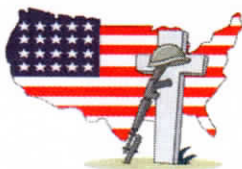

A Conclusion and a Transition

Please turn to Hebrews 10:11-39 (pg. 1006 in the pew Bible)

Hebrews 10:11-14 - A Summary Statement

- V. 11- priest stands, repeatedly, same sacrifices...
- V.12 – Christ, single sacrifice, sat down...

Hebrews 10:14- For by one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy.

- The solution

Warning! Don't turn back!

- It can never take away your sin...
- Futility of the past
- A sow when washed returns to the mud...

Hebrews 11:14- For by one sacrifice he has made perfect forever those who are being made holy

- Made Perfect, made holy, sanctified
- Taken out of the category of being profane
- Past, present, and future

We are to be what we are in Christ!

If holiness, if growing in Christlikeness does not define us as individuals... the present tense reality of our being sanctified is in question, and truly our claim to be in Christ is challenged!
