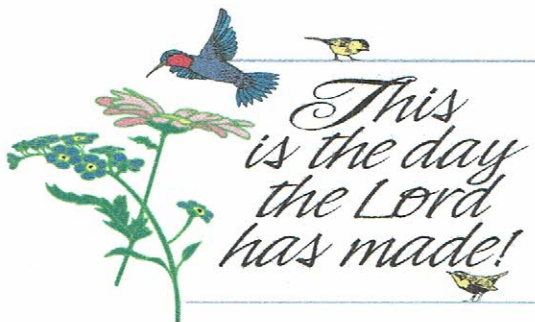

Please turn to Jonah (pg. 774 in the pew Bible)

Jonah is about....

- God's grace for the wicked
- God's sovereignty over His servants

Jonah is not so much about the great fish that appears in the middle of the book, but it is to teach Jonah (and us) that we have a gracious God...

2 Kings 14:25 - He restored the border of Israel from Lebo-hamath as far as the Sea of the Arabah, according to the word of the Lord, the God of Israel, which he spoke by his servant Jonah the son of Amittai, the prophet, who was from Gath-hepher.

Nineveh

- Nahum 3 - woe to the bloody city full of lies and plunder, there is no end to their prey.

Psalms 67:1-2 - May God be gracious to us and bless us and make his face to shine upon us, that your way may be known on earth, your saving power among all nations.
