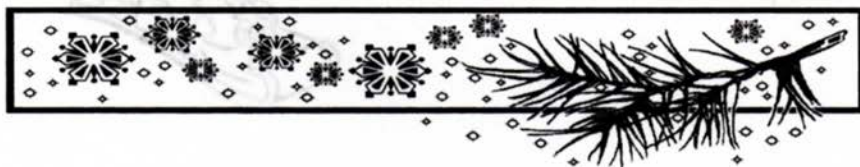

The Public Faith Conference is a unique opportunity to learn how to better engage, listen and share our hope in Christ with our friends, family and co-workers. Redeemer has partnered with Ravi Zacharias International Ministries (RZIM) to bring three internationally recognized apologists to train and equip Christians on sharing their faith.

- 6.Sexual identity and the Gospel by Sam Allberry

Livestream will be watched downstairs in the church fellowship hall. Doors will be open at 6:30 on Friday Feb. 16th

For those who would like breakfast of Saturday February 17th doors will open at 8:00 and breakfast will be served at 8:30 (please sign up and indicate if you will be joining us for breakfast)

There will be soup, salad, and bread available for lunch on Saturday. The conference will end at 4:30.

The conference info indicates that there will be Q&A with each of the speakers. I do not know exactly what the schedule consists of. I am hopeful there will be some time available for us to engage in our own discussions regarding the conference material.

In many ways we will be navigating through this as it happens. I invite everyone to come and sit in on this conference. This is not a highly organized and formal gathering, I intend this to be a relaxed atmosphere where we can come together in fellowship and truly consider how we might best live out our faith and our witness in the current culture. And I hope to be able to engage in some very honest and open discussion about the things we will hear.

Please come if you can, and please pray for those who will be able to be there. The world around us is in desperate need of the grace and mercy of God through the gospel of Jesus Christ, and we are the ones He has commissioned to share the gospel. Pray that this conference will give us a greater passion for sharing the gospel of Jesus, and pray that it will help us to share it more effectively.

Hebrews 8:1-6 - Jesus Christ is the reigning king of the Kingdom of Heaven!
