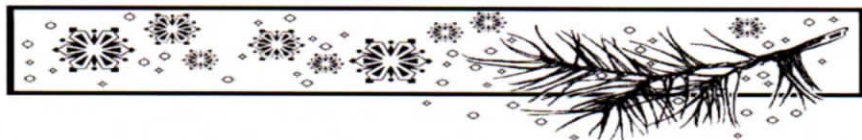

The Holy Place, The Most Holy Place, and The Veil
Please turn to Hebrews 9:1-10 (pg. 1005 in the pew Bible)

New Covenant is vastly superior to the Old Covenant

- Earthly sanctuary of the Old Covenant
- Heavenly sanctuary of the New Covenant

Hebrews 9:8-9a By this the Holy Spirit indicates that the way into the holy places is not yet opened as long as the first section is still standing 9 (which is symbolic for the present age).

2 Sections separated by a veil

- Old Covenant- limited access-
- Priests aware of 2 things
 - God's presence on the other side
 - Direct access denied
- Day of atonement emphasized it all the more

The Holy Spirit teaches us the significance of the Holy Place, The Most Holy Place and the veil

- V.9 ...symbolic for the present age...
- Not 2 stages of Christian life

1John 1:8 - If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us.

Galatians 2:20 - The life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God

What did the priests do when the veil was torn?

- Sewed it, replaced it, still dwell in the outer court

The veil is torn, the barrier is gone, and we are invited into the presence of God. Are you boldly approaching the throne of grace, or have you but a veil back up? Are you living in the Most Holy Place or are you content to stay in the outer court?
