Our Promised Eternal Inheritance

Please turn to Hebrews 9:15-22 (pg. 1006 in the pew Bible) and Ephesians 1:11-23 (pg.976)

Hebrews 9:15 - Therefore he is the mediator of a new covenant.... Why?

- so that those who are called may receive *the promised eternal inheritance*

Galatians 3:29- If you are Christ's then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to the promise

2 Corinthians 4:7- We have this treasure in *jars of clay*

- the surpassing power belongs to God
- ...so we do not lose heart
- Seen things are transient; Unseen is eternal

Hebrews 9:16 – Where a will is involved, the death of the one who made it must be established.

- Our Joy is found in our inheritance, the promises of God!

1 Peter 1:4 - An inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you,

Romans 8:16-17- The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, 17 and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be glorified with him.

1 John 3:1-2- See what kind of love the Father has given to us, that we should be called children of God; and so we are... Beloved, we are God's children now, and what we will be has not yet appeared; but we know that when he appears we shall be like him, because we shall see him as he is.

...Having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints!
