Justification by Faith

Please turn to Hebrews 11 (pg. 1007 in the pew Bible), Romans 1:18-20 (pg. 939), and Genesis 4:1-5 (pg. 4)

Hebrews 11:3...By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God...

- Romans 1:18-20

Hebrews 11:4 – Saving faith and the gospel

- Abel commended as righteous

Genesis 4:1-5

- Abel's offering was better than Cain's because of faith
- Without faith it is impossible to please God
- Romans 14:23 -Whatever does not proceed from faith is sin

What did they know about offerings?

- Genesis 3:21
- Sin requires a blood sacrifice

By faith, Abel brought the sacrifice his sin required, Cain brought a self-righteous offering on his terms...

- Hebrews 9:22- without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sin

There is only one way to be made righteous and acceptable to God, we must come by faith in Jesus Christ as God's sacrifice for our sin...

- No one comes to the Father but by me...
- By Faith... Abel was commended as righteous
