Hebrews 10:32-39 – Encouragement for the Faithful

10:32 -34 - **But** recall the former days when you were enlightened...

- The past is an important resource for the present!
 - Faithfulness of God
 - Joshua (Standing Stones)
 - Not “*the good old days*”
- When in trouble... mine out treasures for the future!
 - ... better possession and an abiding one

10:38- “But my righteous one shall live by faith, and if he shrinks back, my soul has no pleasure in him.”
